## Extension

Extension is one of the three missions of a land-grant institution and, as such, we work to take science-based information to the citizens of Alabama, the Southeast, the United States, and the world. The goal is to improve quality of life as it relates to a variety of natural resources issues. In 2017, the Forestry, Wildlife, and Natural Resources (FWNR) team assisted clientele by providing workshops and publications on a variety of topics.

### HIGHLIGHTS

- Presented more than 400 workshops and field days reaching more than 40,000 clients
- Presented 3 ForestHer Workshops for women from 5 states
- Hosted the 17th National Wildlife Damage Management Conference
- Videos dealing with wild pig management received more than 1.6 million views from more than 194 countries.
- 1,380 Alabamians participated in workshops to increase their knowledge of invasive plant identification and control
- Trained 1,485 tree care workers in assessing tree risks and preservation.
- 175 landowners attended field days related to shortleaf pine management.
- Responded to more than 1,000 wildlife damage complaints providing a potential savings of more than \$200,000.
